

CLE Accreditation

It is the responsibility of each participant to file the appropriate paperwork with your state bar(s) for continuing legal education credit for this course.

Accreditation will be sought in Colorado and in Texas. CLE accreditation is granted on a state-by-state basis. Each state has its own rules and regulations that define eligible course content for CLE credit. Due to varying state bar approval procedures, this course is typically accredited for 13-19 CLE credits.

Registrants may request accreditation from specific states after the workshop has taken place by usually providing course materials. (Note: IMLA is a certified provider of CLE programs in many states, and their co-sponsorship of this program will be useful in securing CLE credits.)
