#### The First Amendment



Gongress shall make no law respecting an establishment of religion, or prohibiting the free exercise thereof; or abridging the freedom of speech, or of the press; or the right of the people peaceably to assemble, and to petition the Government for a redress of grievances.

#### Airports are (generally) nonpublic forums







Areas outside airport terminals



#### Regulation of nonpublic forums



Viewpoint neutral

Reasonable, in light of the purposes of the forum and the surrounding circumstances



#### What is reasonable?

- Policies should be in writing, not ad hoc.
- Policies cannot "confer unbridled discretion" on officials.
- There must be a <u>reasonable opportunity</u> to exercise rights.
- Courts have upheld permit requirements, speech zones, crowd/sign size, and prohibitions on voice amplification.
  - Safe and efficient movement of passengers and employees
  - Security implications
  - Coordination with parking, security, other contractors

#### **Content-neutral regulation**


• Must be narrowly tailored to further a legitimate government interest while leaving open alternative channels for communication.

#### **Content-based regulation**

• Restrictions must be narrowly drawn to serve a compelling state interest.



- Standards for collection and handling personal data






#### Does the GDPR apply to U.S. airports?




